

Privacy Policy

Changee S.r.l, with registered office in Via G.P. from Palestrina 63 - 00193 Rome - P.I. 09093070960, in the person of the pro tempore Legal Representative, Data Controller of the profiling (also referred to as the "Controller"), as required by art. 13 of the GDPR EU 2016/679 ("General Data Protection Regulation"), provides users who visit the website <https://www.changee.it> (hereinafter also referred to as the "website") information relating to the processing of their data.

Browsing data

During their normal operation, the IT systems and software procedures, used to operate this website, acquire some personal data, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols. This is information that is not collected to be associated with identified interested parties, but which by its very nature could, through processing and association with data held by third parties, allow users to be identified. This category of data includes the IP addresses or domain names of the computers used by users who connect to the website, the addresses in URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) form of the requested resources, the time of the request, the method used in submitting the request to the server, the size of the file obtained in response, the numerical code indicating the status of the response given by the server (successful, error, etc.) and other parameters relating to the operating system and the user's computer environment.

This data is used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the website and to check its correct functioning. The data could also be used to ascertain responsibility in the event of any computer crimes against the website.

Cookies

This website uses only technical cookies. For all specifications, please refer to the cookie information on the website.

Data provided directly by the user

The personal data provided by the user in a discretionary way (so, for example, when requesting information or explanations by writing to the e-mail addresses or when filling out the check list on the website) is used for the sole purpose of carrying out any requests made and for the execution of pre-contractual obligations and/or legal and/or contractual obligations deriving from the legal relationship in the case established. Specific information is given in the forms and in the areas of the website dedicated to particular services that require the provision of data by the user. The user who releases data that relates to third parties operates as an independent controller and therefore assumes all the obligations and responsibilities provided for by the Regulation regarding their processing, guarantees that he/she has acquired and processes the data of third parties, in case transmitted, in accordance with the industry legislation referred to and hold Changee Srl harmless with respect to claims, disputes and claims for damages related to the provision of third party data.

Conferring data

With the exception of browsing data, necessary to implement IT and telematic protocols, the provision of personal data by users is free and optional. However, failure to provide the aforementioned data will make it impossible to respond to requests.

Methods of data processing

The data processing is performed through IT systems. The data is stored in electronic archives with the adoption of the appropriate security measures provided for in the Regulation. The data will be processed only by authorized persons (to whom a specific appointment as Data Processor or DPO has been conferred)

and stored for the time strictly necessary to process the requests of the data subject and in any case in compliance with the terms of the law.

Place

For the processing of data connected to the website services, the Data Controller uses servers located within the European territory.

Communication

The collected data will not be disclosed, sold or exchanged with third parties without the express consent of the data subject, except in cases where communication to third parties (companies providing IT supply and assistance services) is necessary to fulfill legal obligations or fulfill the obligations deriving from the relationship with the data subject or third parties (falling into the category indicated) who operate as data processors. The data subject may request the list of appointed data processors from the Data Controller.

Rights of the data subject

The data subject can assert at any time, by contacting the data controller, by sending an email to info@Changee.it, the rights referred to in Articles 12-22 of the GDPR EU 2016/679, which is reported verbatim below.

1. The data subject has the right to obtain confirmation on whether personal data concerning them exists or not, even if not yet registered, and its communication in intelligible form (Art.15 GDPR EU 2016/679).

2. The data subject has the right to obtain (Art.13 GDPR UE 2016/679):

a) the origin of personal data;

b) the purposes and methods of processing;

c) the logic applied in case of treatment carried out with the aid of electronic instruments;

d) the identity of the Owner, DPO and the Data Processor appointed pursuant to article 5, paragraph 2;

e) the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the personal data may be communicated to or who can learn about them as appointed representative in the territory of the State, managers or agents.

3. The data subject has the right to obtain (Art.16-17 GDPR UE 2016/679):

a) update, rectification or, when applicable, integration of data;

b) the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in violation of the law, including those for which retention is unnecessary for the purposes for which the data was collected or subsequently processed;

c) the statement that the operations referred to in letters a) and b) have been brought to the attention, also with regards to their content, of those to whom the data have been communicated or disseminated, except in the case where this fulfillment proves impossible or involves the use of means manifestly disproportionate to the protected right.

4. The data subject has the right to object, in whole or in part (Art.21 GDPR UE 2016/679):

a) for legitimate reasons, the processing of personal data concerning him/her, even if pertinent to the purpose of the collection;

b) to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending advertising materials or direct selling or for carrying out market research or commercial communication.
